The interactive format is designed to help parents identify the source of their child's behavior and learn what they can do about it.

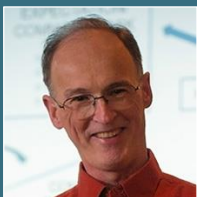
